# Learning Time - Sign Language

Continue to work with your children at home with any of their sign-language words. Any kind of repetition of the lessons they learn with improve their daily communication.



**Cookie** - Place the right C thumb and fingertips into the left flat palm and twist a few times.

**Ball** - Curve both hands with the fingertips touching as if holding a ball. Let the thumbs and index fingers



face the observer.



**Mother** - Touch the right chin or cheek with the

thumb of the right open hand. The fingers may be wiggled slightly.

**Father** - Touch the forehead with the thumb of the right open hand. The fingers may be wiggled slightly.



**Sister** - Trace the right jawbone from ear to chin with the palm side of the right A thumb. Then point both index fingers forward and bring them together.

**Brother** - Move the right hand to the forehead as though gripping the peak of a hat between the fingers and thumb; then move it forward a few inches. Next,



point both index fingers forward and bring them together.



**Please** - Make a circle with the right flat hand over the heart.

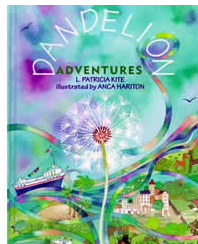


**Thank-you** - Touch the lips with the fingertips of one or both flat hands, then move the hands forward until the palms are facing up. It is natural to smile and nod the head while making this sign.

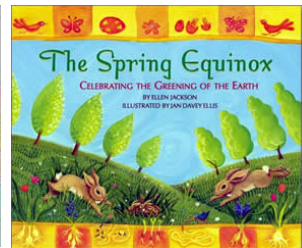
## Books to Read
