Learning Time - Sign Language

We continue to review all the words that we have worked on in the past as well and learning the alphabet, signing while singing. It is very helpful to repeat these lessons at home to help with communication in everyday situations. I notice every time they learn a new word they light up in excitement that they understand what we are working on-it's so awesome to see how happy they are with themselves!

natural to smile and nod the head while making this sign.

Milk - Squeeze both slightly open S hands with a downward motion, alternating hands.



Eat - The right *and* hand moves toward the mouth a few times.



Hurt - Place the right middle finger on the heart with the other fingers extended; then twist the hand quickly forward and outward from the wrist.

Water - Touch the mouth of the index finger of the right W hand a few times.



Yes - The right "S" hand

represents the nodding of your head. Raise and lower your fist, bending at the wrist.

No - Bring the right thumb, index and middle fingers together while shaking the head side to side.



More - Touch the fingertips of both hands before the chest with palms facing down. The right hand can be brought up to meet the left from slightly lower position.



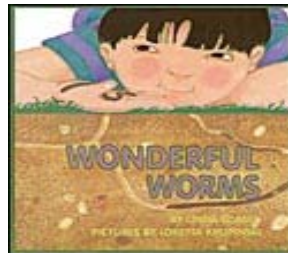
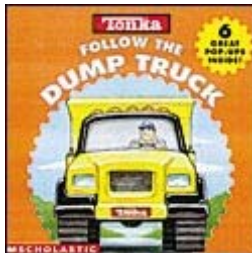
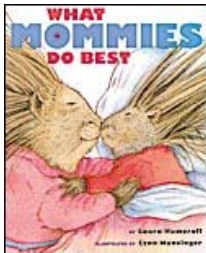
Please - Make a circle with the right flat hand over the heart.
