Preschool & Crafts

I will be working with all of the children on an individual basis and provide each one with the materials needed to improve their skills. We will continue our 'gardening' and hopefully see some of the little ones flowers and veggies grow into something beautiful so take home shortly.

Learning Time - Sign Language Words

Using sign language in a group setting has really enhanced the vocal skills with the little ones. They can communicate to one another before verbally perfecting a word. Using sign language helps children under-

stand words at an earlier age than just talking to them and their physical skills are much more advanced than verbal skills, making it easier for them to tell you what they want or what they are trying to say!

I will be taking a couple of days off later this month-please mark your calendars of these dates and find alternate care (if needed) on these days; Thursday June 19 and Friday June 20. Remember that pay will be due on Wednesday of that week.

8. I know all the latest in kids songs, fashions, sayings and health issues.

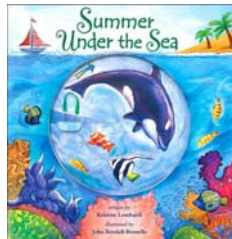
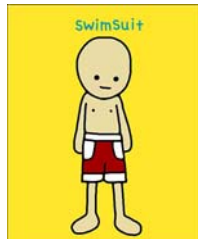
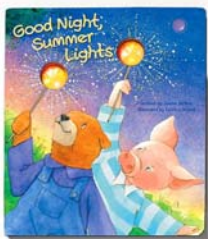
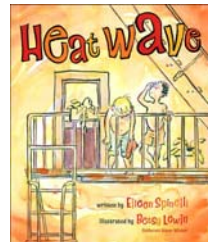
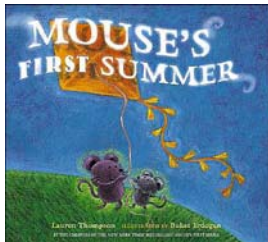
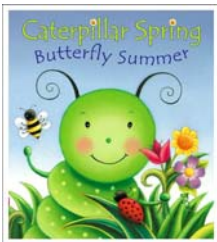
9. I get paid to play with finger-paint and make a mess if I want to.

of your very best friends!

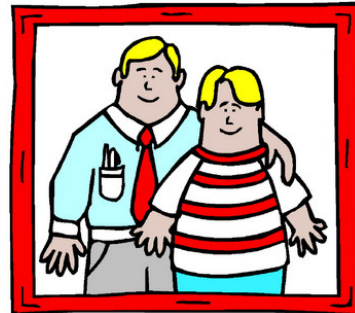
He's proud of your
